BACKGROUND

Organization: Humanity-Increased

Project Name: Qurbani 2025 – Uganda

Project Location: Mbale & Manafwa Districts, Eastern Uganda

Number of Beneficiaries: 175 households (776 individuals)

In Eastern Uganda, access to high-quality protein remains limited for many rural families. With poverty and food insecurity affecting a significant portion of the population, Eid al-Adha presents a critical opportunity to provide both nourishment and dignity to vulnerable households.

In 2025, Humanity-Increased implemented its Qurbani program across the districts of Mbale and Manafwa. The initiative aimed to provide fresh, halal meat during Eid to families who rarely consume meat due to financial hardship. By combining spiritual values with humanitarian action, this program addressed both immediate nutritional needs and the joy of religious celebration.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES & OUTPUTS



1. COORDINATION & PLANNING

Preparatory meetings were held with local leaders and volunteers to align roles, establish distribution protocols, and ensure compliance with Islamic slaughter guidelines.

2. BENEFICIARY SELECTION

A community-based survey identified 175 households facing severe food insecurity, prioritizing:

- Women-headed households
- Orphans and vulnerable children
- Families with limited access to protein
- Elderly or chronically ill individuals





3.SLAUGHTER & LOGISTICS

Eight cows were carefully selected and approved through veterinary inspection to meet Islamic Qurbani requirements. Slaughter took place on 6 June 2025, the day of Eid al-Adha, under hygienic conditions and the supervision of religious scholars.

4. DISTRIBUTION STRATEGY

The meat was divided into 3-kilogram portions, packaged, and distributed the same day to ensure freshness and alignment with Eid observance. A total of 525 kilograms of meat was delivered across the two districts.
