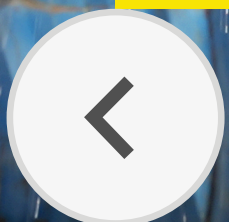

# BACKGROUND

**Organization:** Humanity-Increased

**Project Name:** Water for Sudan – Emergency Water Tankering

**Project Location:** Al-Qadarif State, Sudan

**Project Start Date:** February 1, 2026

**Project End Date:** March 31, 2026

**Total Beneficiaries:** 300 households per day (approximately 1,500 individuals daily)

Sudan continues to face one of the largest displacement crises globally, driven by ongoing conflict since 2023. Millions of internally displaced persons (IDPs) have been forced to relocate, with Al-Qadarif State receiving a significant influx of families fleeing violence. This rapid displacement has severely strained basic services, particularly access to clean and safe water.

In IDP settlements, many families rely on unsafe water sources or costly vendors, increasing the risk of waterborne diseases, including cholera. Limited infrastructure and overcrowded conditions further exacerbate the crisis, especially for women, children, and vulnerable households.

To address this urgent need, Humanity-Increased implemented a one-month emergency water tankering intervention to provide reliable access to safe water for displaced families in Al-Qadarif State.

# PROJECT ACTIVITIES & OUTPUTS



## 1. NEEDS ASSESSMENT & BENEFICIARY IDENTIFICATION

Rapid field assessments were conducted to identify IDP locations experiencing acute water shortages.

Selection prioritized:

High-density IDP settlements

Households with limited access to safe water

Female-headed households

Families with elderly or persons with disabilities

Target locations and beneficiary groups were verified prior to implementation.

## 2. PROCUREMENT & CONTRACTING OF WATER TANKERS

Qualified water tanker suppliers were identified and contracted. Water sources were verified to ensure safety and compliance with health standards. Logistics planning ensured timely and consistent delivery.



### 3. WATER DISTRIBUTION



A total of 108 water tankers were delivered over the project period, averaging 6 tankers per day. Each tanker carried approximately 14,310 liters of water, resulting in a total distribution of approximately 1,545,480 liters . Each tanker served approximately 50 families, ensuring daily access to safe water for approximately 300 households.



### 4. DISTRIBUTION MANAGEMENT

Water was delivered to designated communal distribution points within IDP settlements. Distribution was organized to ensure:

- Safe access for beneficiaries
- Reduced congestion and wait times
- Equitable allocation across households
